

## CYPRESS LAKES VILLAGE POOL RULES

AS OF JULY 2018

1. Use of the pool is a privilege extended to Cypress Lakes Village Owners Association members whose annual dues are paid in full and for whom no restrictive covenant violations are outstanding.
2. Pool Access Key must be in possession when using the pool.
3. NO LIFEGUARDS ARE ON DUTY AT ANY TIME. SWIM AT YOUR OWN RISK.  
THE ASSOCIATION MANAGEMENT IS NOT RESPONSIBLE FOR ACCIDENTS OR INJURIES.
4. No alcohol or illegal drugs are allowed in the pool area. The Association will cooperate fully with law enforcement agencies to enforce this rule.
5. Pool hours of operation are 9:00 a.m. to 9:00 p.m. daily and from Dawn to 9 a.m. for swimming laps. Anyone entering the pool or pool area outside of these hours is trespassing and subject to arrest. Owners are encouraged to contact the Cumberland County Sheriff's Department if there are persons using the pool outside of hours of operation.
6. Private parties are not permitted at the pool.
7. Residents are responsible at all times for the conduct of their guests and for any damage that is done. The resident must be present while any guests are at the pool.
8. The Association will not be responsible for any money or property loss sustained by members or their guest when using the pool.
9. Children should not use the pool without adult supervision. Infants are required to wear reusable swim diapers. Regular and disposable diapers including *Little Swimmers* or similar products are prohibited. Dispose of diapers in restroom trashcans.
10. Residents are limited to two (2) guests regardless of the number of residents in the family. This means two guests per house; not one guest per family member or owner. Guests must be accompanied by residents at all time. Residents shall not open the gate to admit anyone they do not recognize as a Cypress Lakes Village Owners Association member.
11. Only authorized personnel are permitted in the pool pump/equipment room.
12. Pool furniture may not be removed from the pool area.
13. Showers are required before entering the pool. Suntan oils and lotions can permanently damage the filter system.
14. NO PETS/ANIMALS are permitted in the pool area other than service animals. For all service animals, pre-registration is required with the Association.

15. No glass, porcelain, pottery or other breakable containers of any kind are permitted in the pool area. Anyone found with any type of glass (besides eyewear) will lose pool privileges for the balance of the pool season. Plastic containers, pop tops, and cans must be disposed of in a waste container.
16. Each resident is responsible for policing and cleaning up after him/herself. Failure to do so will result in you being billed for cleaning services and may result in the loss of pool privileges.
17. Persons acting in an obnoxious manner can be barred from further use of the pool.
18. No running, rough playing, splashing, towel-snapping, any type of personal conduct endangering safety of self and others, foul language, lewd behavior, Frisbees, bikes, scooters, skates or skateboards are allowed in the pool or pool area. No diving in the pool, flips from the side of the pool, or throwing children from shoulders is allowed at any time. Additionally, no smoking or chewing gum is allowed in the pool area.
19. Proper swimming attire (bathing suits) is required when using the pool. No cutoffs are permitted. Residents and guest must remove hair clips and pins before entering the pool. Shoulder length or longer hair must be pulled back or in a bathing cap.
20. No persons with skin, eye, ear or nasal infections are allowed in the pool. No persons with a communicable disease are allowed in the pool.
21. The door/gate to the pool area must be kept closed. Please make sure the door is closed when passing through. Entrance is only through the designated entrance. Climbing over the fence is not permitted.
22. No blaring music is allowed. Please use the facility in a normal, quiet manner in order to allow the maximum use and enjoyment by others.
23. No large rafts or flotation devices shall be allowed in the pool. Balls, small baby floats and noodles may be allowed based on the number of people in the pool.
24. Adults should not swim alone.
25. The pool is closed during thunder and/or lightning storms.
26. Association management may suspend pool privileges if any resident/guest is found violating the pool rules. Disciplinary action may include temporary removal from the pool, immediate expulsion from the pool, suspension of pool privileges, or further disciplinary action as determined by the Board of Directors.
